

## - TECHNICAL RIDER -

The Band is well experienced in playing acoustically and doesn't need any amplification to function within itself.
When amplified, it is ideally positioned in a close setup on stage and without monitoring. Full amplification and 1-2 monitors are only needed for an audience larger than 150 people.
Chairs without armrests for all band members.
FULL AMPLIFICATION (for more than 150 people) :

| INSTRUMENT | MICROPHONE (or similar) |
| :--- | :--- |
| Vocal | $2 \times$ SM 58 |
| Violin | $1 \times$ SM 58 |
| Saxophone/Clarinet | $1 \times$ Sennheiser MD 421/441 |
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| Banjo/Mandolin | $1 \times$ SM 58 |
| Guitar | $1 \times$ SM 58 |
| Tuba/Uprightbass | $1 \times$ Sennheiser E614 |
| Piano (if in the venue) | $2 \times$ overheads |

HALF - ACOUSTIC (for less than 150 people) :
For this setup we usually only support the quiet instruments.
Such as:

1-2 $x$ vocal microphone
$1 \times$ vocal microphone which is also used for violin
$1 \times$ guitar mic
$1 x$ banjo/mandolin
